1) ----- Tavern is the name of the queer friendly pub that was the sanctuary of the Plymouth Queer scene until its closure in 1982.

2) Mark ----- was a trans (Or possibly Intersex) sportman, who won gold in the women's Javelin before Transitioning.

3) The bookshop -- ----- was opened by Prudence de Villers and Gay Jones in 1982. By selling gay and lesbian titles (Plus Environmental and antiwar stuff) it was a radical departure from any other Plymouth bookshop of its time. It closed in 2007.

4) ---- was the year of the first Gay Pride in Plymouth

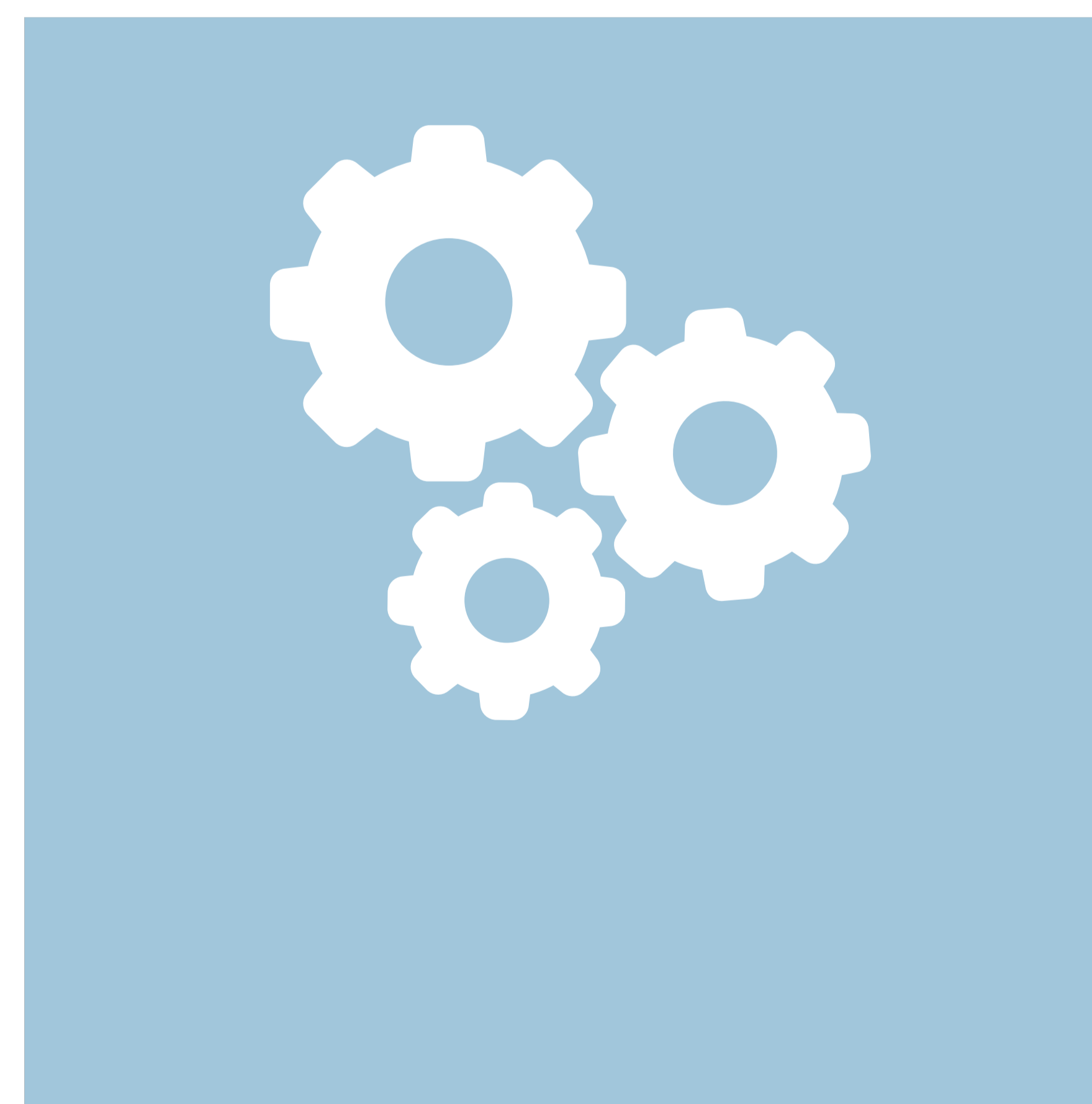
5) ----- was the name of queer club owner who made a name for himself in Plymouth. He had a foul mouthed Parrot (none of those words can be found here)

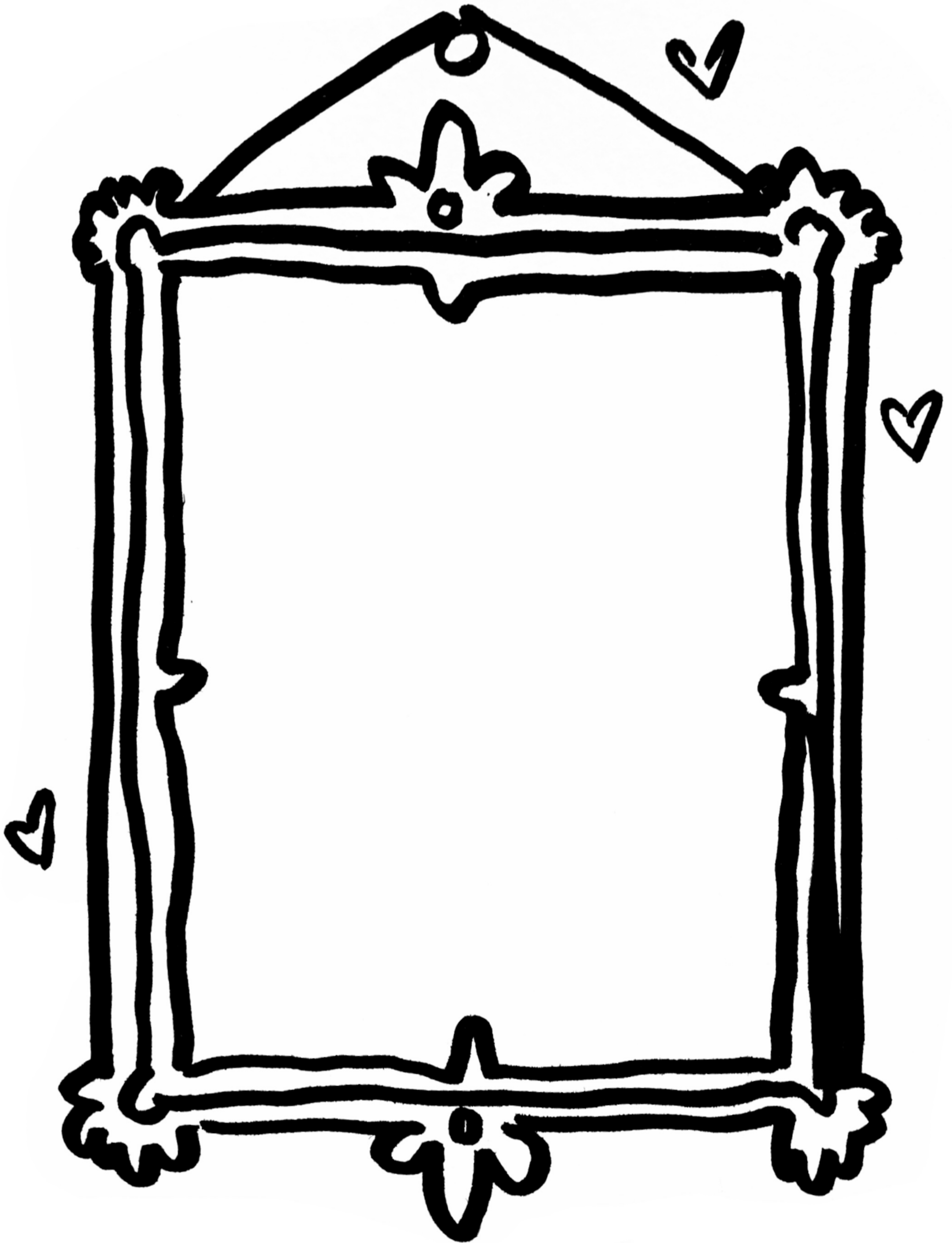

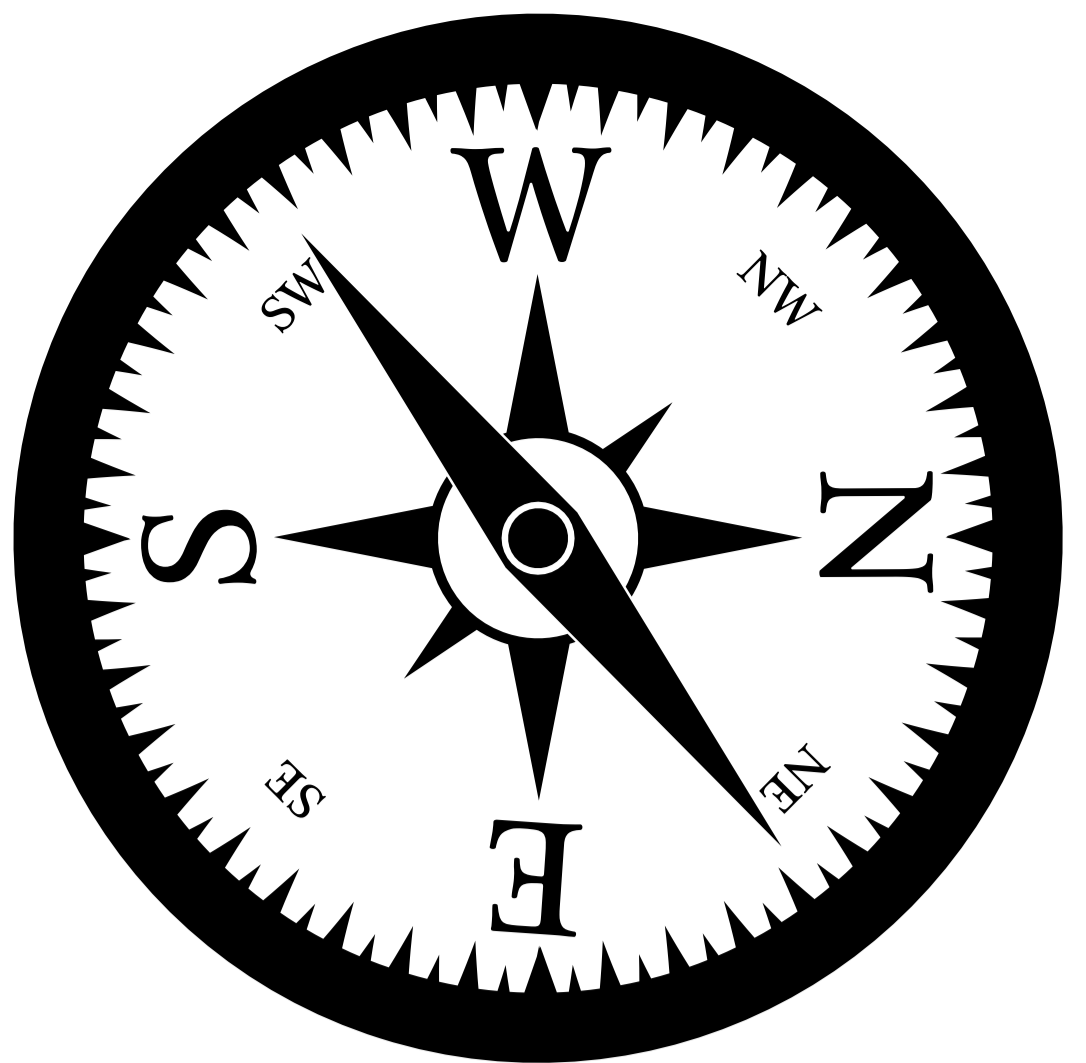


